Horseshoe Meadow Recreation Area

Horseshoe Meadow Recreation Area is located approximately 24 miles southwest of Lone Pine, CA, at an elevation of 10,000 feet. It is a popular staging area for trips into the Golden Trout and John Muir Wilderness Areas and Sequoia National Park.

Campground fees and open dates are subject to change. Fees are posted at the campgrounds. Campfires are prohibited outside of designated fire rings. Pets should be leashed at all times. Bears may break into cars and destroy campsites to access food. Properly secure all food and scented items in onsite bear-resistant lockers when unattended and dispose of trash in bear-resistant garbage bins.

Camping is prohibited outside of the developed campgrounds.

There is a one night stay limit at all campgrounds at Horseshoe Meadow Recreation Area.

Cottonwood Lakes Trailhead

- 13 walk-in sites, all first-come/first-served
- Fire pits, piped water, vault toilets, picnic tables
- \$6.00 per night*

Cottonwood Pass Trailhead

- 18 walk-in sites, all first-come/first-served
- Fire pits, piped water, vault toilets, picnic tables
- \$6.00 per night*

Horseshoe Meadow Equestrian


- 10 sites, all first-come/first-served
- Corral and hitch rail at each site
- Fire pits, piped water, vault toilets, picnic tables
- \$12.00 per night*
- Equestrians only

June through October.


Directions
